With assistance from the SAA Foundation, SAA's Digital Archives Specialist (DAS) Curriculum development began in July 2011.

At this time, 11 <u>course examinations</u> (for existing courses) have been created and implemented:

- 1. Basic Electronic Records
- 2. Basics of Managing Electronic Records: Getting You Started
- 3. Thinking Digital
- 4. Beginner's Guide to Metadata
- 5. Electronic Records and Archives: The Next Step
- 6. Essentials of Digital Repositories
- 7. Digital Archives and Libraries
- 8. Achieving Email Account Preservation with XML
- 9. Archival Content Management systems
- 10. Preservation Options of PDF
- 11. Managing Electronic Records in Archives and Special Collections

Eight <u>new courses</u> are in various stages of development:

- 1. Appraisal of Electronic Records
- 2. Arrangement and Description of Electronic Records
- 3. Digital Repositories
- 4. Legal Issues in Digital Archives
- 5. Developing Specifications and RFPs for Recordkeeping Systems
- 6. Inreach and Outreach for Digital Archives
- 7. Digital Forensics
- 8. Information Architecture

In addition, development of the following three <u>new courses</u> has been completed and they have been offered at least once during this fiscal year:

- 1. Standards for Digital Archives
- 2. Digital Curation: Creating an Environment for Success
- 3. Preserving Digital Archives: Concepts and Competencies
